You may have been to Switzerland, but you may NOT have seen this Switzerland! Spend 7 nights in the quaint alpine village of Wengen (1,000 people at 4,180 feet), surrounded by 14,000 foot mountains like the Eiger, Monch, and Jungfrau.

Days 1 & 2 To Zurich / To Wengen (D)
Depart for Switzerland. Arrive the following
morning, board your coach and travel to the capital
city, Bern, to see the Rose Gardens & Glockenspiel.
Then, drive up into the massive Swiss Alps. The
scenery is increasingly spectacular as you arrive
in Lauterbrunnen, with its towering cliffs. Travel by
cog railway up to the enchanting alpine village of
Wengen for 7 nights (altitude 4,180').

#### Day 3 Interlaken / Lake Cruise (BD)

Enjoy a day trip to Interlaken to shop for woolens, lace, and watches. Ride the vintage cog rail up to Schynige Platte for an incredible view (altitude 6,800'). Later, cruise across Lake Brienz to visit the Wood Carving School. Board the Swiss Rail back to Lauterbrunnen, then by cog rail up to Wengen.

#### Day 4 Jungfrau / Grindelwald (B)

Free morning or optional rail up the Jungfraujoch Mountain at 11,133 feet (optional at approx. \$85 pp due to altitude). This afternoon, we will all go via cog railway to Grindelwald for shopping. Continue to "Summit in First" via Europe's longest cable car (altitude 7,600'). Then, return to Wengen via the Männlichenbahn cable car.

#### Day 5 Schwarzwald/Aare Gorge (BD)

Ride the cable car & gondola over to Grindelwald. Board a Postbus for an excursion over the Grosse Scheidegg to Schwarzwaldalp. Stop and walk thru the amazing 600' deep Aare River Gorge or take the bus to Meiringen and visit the Sherlock Holmes Museum. Then, ride the Swiss Rail along Lake Brienz and back to Interlaken & Wengen.



Board the cog railway to glacier-carved Lauterbrunnen Valley. Board a Postbus to Trummelbach Falls. Go inside the mountain and see how the falls have carved incredible caves. Next, take the cable car up to Gimmelwald, then to Murren for free time.
